MATERIALS

- Ceramic Christmas Tree
 - Sponge Fan Brush
- Medium Round Brush
- Detail Brush Stylus

• Use any colors and specialty glazes you like from the available selection.

TIPS

Before painting, wipe the piece down with a damp sponge to remove ceramic dust.

Apply 3 coats for solid color, and allow paint to dry between coats.

Make sure to check that all light holes are open and not clogged with paint.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe down the tree and the base with a damp sponge.

2. Paint the tree and the base separately. Do not mount the tree onto the base while painting. Allow underglazes to dry completely between the coats.

3. When painting the tree, use a fan brush to easily reach all the crevasses of the piece. Some paint will fill the holes during this process. Use a stylus to unclog the holes while the paint is still soft.

4. Use smaller brushes to add details as desired.

5. After the tree is glazed and fired, insert the lights, plug in, and enjoy.
